



1. **TINTAGEL:** Legendary birthplace and coastal stronghold of Arthur.



2. **KING ARTHUR'S GREAT HALLS:** Beautiful stained glass windows and displays depicting the mediaeval Arthurian romances.



3. **BOSSINEY MOUND:** One great legend says that on Midsummer's Eve the Round Table like "shimmering silver" hovers above this ancient site.



4. **ST NECTAN'S GLEN:** Where Arthur's knights were blessed before the Quest for the Holy Grail.



5. **SLAUGHTERBRIDGE:** Site of 6<sup>th</sup> century 'King Arthur's Stone' marking the site of Arthur and Mordred's last battle of Camlann. Many stories are told through art, literature and video in The Land of Arthur Exhibition.



6. **CAMELFORD:** Legendary site of Camelot. Beautiful market town with free parking for local shops, pubs, park and Tourist Information Centre.
